

## 390 23' SSB Whip Antenna

IMPORTANT! Please read all instructions before installing.

WARNING: Installation of this product near power lines is dangerous! Check for overhead wires before installing.

Thank you for purchasing a Shakespeare antenna product. Shakespeare works hard to build reliability and durability into all of its products for maximum customer satisfaction.

The 390 is a 23', two-section SSB whip antenna with conductors running full length. The antenna's design supports power up to 1 KW. Its chrome-plated brass ferrule has 1"-14 threads. Use a Shakespeare 410-R Mounting Kit (sold separately).

#### **TOOLS REQUIRED:**

• Crescent wrench or 1/2" opened wrench

#### INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Choose a mounting location that is as high as practical, as free as possible from obstructions.

- Thread the tip section onto the base section's upper ferrule, including the lockwasher as shown in the diagram, and securely tighten
- 2. Use 409 or 410 mounting hardware (not supplied) to mount the antenna to a deck or bulk-head. Instructions for installing the mounts are included with the mounting kits.
- 3. SSB antennas and radio require adequate grounding systems. Follow the radio manufacturer's instructions for connecting this antenna to your SSB radio.

#### WARNING

Installation of this product near power lines is dangerous! Check for overhead wires before installing!

**TECH TIP**: This antenna will read "shorted" from Point A to Point B (see diagram) when tested with an ohm meter or continuity tester.
